Pipeline Project Five

Construction on Phase One of Project Five, a residential LPG (Liquid Petroleum Gas) pipeline project, began in December 2004 with a completion time of approximately 90 days. This pipeline will supply roughly 1,000 residential homes for a master planned community in the Guizhou Province of China. The homes are already sold-out and under an exclusive 40 year supply contract with Largo Vista Group, Ltd.

Largo Vista Group, Ltd. has six residential pipeline projects under various stages from construction to completion. All of the company pipelines can handle either LPG or NG (natural gas). LGOV's management spearheaded the organization of the first LPG association, Zunyi Gas Association, the members of which helped standardize new guidelines for the LPG market in the Guizhou Province (population 40 million).

The use of LPG modernizes these residential homes and increases the value of the project for both the developer and the homeowner. The average LPG usage per household is approximately 70 RMB per month with this average representing cooking only. LGOV's pipelines call for the Price Supervision Bureau to regulate charges with the end user, based upon our cost/budget, which will act as a guarantee for the pipelines to have a budget surplus.

Largo Vista Group, Ltd. is working with the Chinese government in improving the environment with alternatives to coal and wood use - a priority for the nation. The provincial government has allocated approximately 40 billion US dollars in assets to improve its infrastructure over the next 10 years. New roads have linked the towns and innovative power generating capacity has raised the potential living standard for 40 million citizens in the province. Largo Vista has taken the lead in residential pipeline construction and continues to negotiate more projects for the future.
